Summer Enrichment Program

OBJECTIVES:

- To provide academic enrichment to campers during the summer break when students tend to forget what they learned the previous school year.
- To provide fun learning activities to address the areas of reading, written language, and mathematics.
- To provide recreational activities to enhance the students musical and artistic abilities.
- To provide trips that promote learning in an enjoyable and safe atmosphere.

- Camp begins on June 21st, 2010 and will end on August 13th, 2010.
- The tuition is \$140.00 per week (cash, money order, credit/debit) and includes snacks, lunch, and all trips
- Full payment discount \$1000 (8wks) or \$500 (4weeks)

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a student entering kindergarten through eighth grade the fall of the upcoming school year.
- Must not have behavioral problems that the staff cannot accommodate within the program. This program is academic in nature with no therapeutic emphasis provided. IEP's will be reviewed on an individual basis to determine if the program fits the student's needs.
- Must have respect for adults and be able to take verbal correction from instructors and staff if necessary.
- **Must commit to the entire 8 week program or the entire 4 week half program..**
- Must pay for the entire program of choice **even if the child is absent for a week.** The staff must still be compensated in the child's absence.

REGISTRATION:

- Applications are available in the school office each Wednesday 4-7:30pm beginning March 26th.
- Early registration is \$50.00 per application (before May 22nd) and \$75 per application after May 22nd.
- Please provide a copy of the student's most recent report card.
